- Provide safe, traffic-free cycling and walking routes for everyone to enjoy.
- Provide a valuable local amenity for communities to walk or cycle.
- Deliver a quality and memorable visitor experience with great scenery and points of interest.
- Complete a circa 330km car-free corridor between Galway and Dublin, linking the Atlantic coast to the East coast.

Part of Ireland's longest Cycleway

The Department of Transport is developing National and Regional Greenways across Ireland to enhance tourism and contribute to rural development.

The new Galway to Athlone Cycleway is a large section of the even bigger circa 330km Galway to Dublin Cycleway - Ireland's longest Cycleway to date.

The Galway to Dublin Cycleway will be a world class amenity for pedestrians, cyclists and wheelchair users to enjoy - locals and tourists alike. It will facilitate the first leg of the international EuroVelo network of long-distance cycling trails in Europe linking Galway to Moscow!

Galway to Dublin Cycleway is being developed in phases:

- The Emerging Preferred Route Corridor is now on display for the Galway to Athlone Cycleway.
- 107km open between Athlone and Maynooth.
- Construction of new cycleway bridge over the Shannon, due to be complete in 2023.
- Two major urban sections being developed between Maynooth and Dublin City and from Ballyloughane to Galway City.

Tá Glasbhealaí Náisiúnta agus Réigiúnacha á bhforbairt ag an Roinn lompair ar fud na hÉireann chun turasóireacht a fheabhsú agus chun cur le forbairt tuaithe.

Is píosa mór den Rotharbhealach níos faide de thuaisceart is 330km idir Gaillimh agus Baile Átha Cliath - an Rotharbhealach is faide in Éirinn go dtí seo - é an Rotharbhealach ó Ghaillimh go Baile Átha Luain.

Taitneamhacht de scóth an domhain a bheidh sa Rotharbhealach ó Ghaillimh go Baile Átha Cliath chun go mbainfidh coisithe, rothaithe agus daoine i gcathaoireachá rotháil sult as - muintir na háite agus turasóirí ar aon. Éascóidh sé an chéad chuid de líonra idirnáisiúnta EuroVelo de chonairí fadraona rothaíochta san Eoraip - ag ceangail Gaillimh le Moscó!

Tá Rotharbhealach na Gaillimhe go Baile Átha Cliath a fhorbairt i gcéimeanna:

- Tá an Chonair Bhealaigh is Dealraíthe a Roghnófar ar taispeáint anois do Rotharbhealach na Gaillimhe go Baile Átha Luain.
- 107km oscailte idir Baile Átha Luain agus Maigh Nuad.
- Droichead nua rotharbhealaigh a thógáil thar an tSionainn, le bheith críochnaithe in 2023.
- Dhá mhór-chuid uirbeacha á bhforbairt idir Maigh Nuad agus Cathair Bhaile Átha Cliath agus ó Bhaile an Locháin go Cathair na Gaillimhe.

Emerging Preferred Route Corridor

The Emerging Preferred Route Corridor has been chosen as it offers a highly scenic route from Galway to Athlone, with lots to see and do on the way. It travels through a wide variety of landscapes, from the edge of Galway Bay, the Burren Low Lands, the Slieve Aughty mountains, the river Shannon and the midlands bogs, and will be attractive to domestic and international users.

It visits Ballyloughane Beach, Oranmore, Rinville, Clarinbridge, Kilcolgan, Kinvara, Coole Park, Gort, Woodford, Portumna, Meelick, Clonfert, Ballinasloe, Shannonbridge and Athlone Castle, linking places of interest, established tourism centres, public parks and outdoor spaces.

We now wish to work with landowners and the public to determine the best route and design for the Cycleway within the Emerging Preferred Route Corridor.

Landowner Engagement

A process has been underway since 2019 to develop a **Code of Best Practice for National and Regional Greenway Projects**. TII and the local authorities have been working with the farming representatives and other stakeholders to develop the Code of Best Practice which is due to be completed in the near future. The Code sets out the process for the delivery and management of Greenways and provides information on the acquisition of privately owned lands for the Greenway.

The corridor is well defined where routing appears clear, for example through publicly owned lands, such as Coillte forestry tracks and Bord na Móna railways.

However, it will be necessary to build some of the Cycleway on land that is now privately owned. In these areas the corridor is wider and future discussions with landowners will form the basis for developing the route within the corridor.

During the development of a preferred route within the corridor, landowners may engage their own agronomist/property adviser to advise them during the design of the Cycleway. This agronomist/property adviser will be paid for by the project promoters. We will work with the landowner and their agronomist/property advisor to pick the least disruptive route possible, likely to be along the property boundary.

We will strive to purchase land through voluntary agreement, if at all possible.

There are a number of dedicated Project Liaison Officers (PLO's) from the Local Authorities and Consultants. The PLO's will be available to meet with landowners either on their property or in the Project Office by appointment. PLO's are also available to talk on the phone or by online virtual meeting.

These PLO's will be the main point of contact for the landowner, and will ensure that the landowners interests and concerns are considered in all decisions.

The goodwill and cooperation of the farming community is important to make the Cycleway a success. Real and open engagement with the landowners and community will be central to everything we do.

Rannpháirtíocht le hÚinéirí Talún

Tá próiseas ar bun ó 2019 chun Cód Dea-Chleachtais a fhorbairt do Thionscadail Glasbhealaigh Náisiúnta agus Réigiúnacha. Bhí TII agus na húdaráis áitiúla ag obair leis na hionadaithe feirmeoireachta agus le páirtithe leasmhara eile chun an Cód Dea-Chleachtais a fhorbairt a bheidh le críochnú go luath. Leagtar an próiseas ina ndéantar glasbhealach a chur ar fáil agus a bhainistiú amach sa Chód agus cuirtear eolas ar fáil ann maidir le talamh príobháideach a cheannach don Ghlasbhealach.

Tá an chonair sainmhínithe go maith nuair is cosúil go bhfuil an bealach soiléir, mar shampla trí thailte faoi úinéireacht phoiblí, mar rianta foraoiseachta Coillte agus iarnróid Bhord na Móna.

Mar sin féin, beidh sé riachtanach cuid den Rotharbhealach a thógáil ar thalamh atá faoi úinéireacht phríobháideachanois. Sna ceantair seo tá an chonair níos leithne agus beidh plé le húinéirí talún amach anseo mar bhunús chun an bealach laistigh den dorchla a fhorbairt.

Le linn dóibh an bealach is fearr a fhorbairt laistigh den chonair, féadfaidh úinéirí talún a n-agranamaí/comhairleoí maoine féin a fhostú chun comhairle a thabhairt dóibh le linn dhearadh an Rotharbhealaigh. Íocfaidh tionscnóirí an tionscadail an t-agranamaí/comhairleoí maoine seo. Oibreomaid leis an úinéir talún agus lena agranamaí/comhairleoí maoine chun an bealach is lú a chuireann isteach air a roghnú, ar dóigh dó a bheith feadh theorainn na maoine.

Déanfaimid ár ndícheall talamh a cheannach trí chomhaontú deonach, más féidir.

Tá roinnt Oifigigh Idirchайдrimh Tionscadail tiomnaithe (PLOanna) ó na hÚdaráis Áitiúla agus Comhairleoí. Beidh na PLOanna ar fáil chun bualadh le húinéirí talún ar a gcuid maoine nó san Oifig Tionscadail trí choinne. Tá PLOanna ar fáil freisin chun labhairt ar an bhfón nó trí chruinníú fiorúil ar líne.

Beidh na PLOanna seo ina bpriomhphointí teaghmála ag an úinéir talún agus cinnteoidh siad go ndéanfar leas agus imní na húinéirí talún a mheas agus cinntí á ndéanamh.

Tá dea-thoil agus comhoibriú an phobail feirmeoireachta tábhachtach chun go n-éireoidh leis an Rotharbhealach. Beidh rannpháirtíocht cheart agus oscailte leis na húinéirí talún agus leis an bpobal lárnach i ngach rud a dhéanaimid.
